The successful tenderer will be promptly advised of the acceptance of his tender and must make payment in full, and take possession of the Lighter within seven days of such advice.

Each tender must be accompanied by a certified cheque for 10 per cent. of its total value, made payable to the Receiver General of Canada, as security deposit for the proper fulfilment of the contract. These cheques will be returned to the unsuccessful tenderers. The cheque of the successful tenderer will be retained until the completion of the contract, and will be subject to forfeiture in the event of the contractor's default. The right to reject any or all of the tenders is reserved.
