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BY-LAW No. _____

OF THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EKFRID.

A By-Law to provide for levying and collecting the amount chargeable to the Township of Ekfrid for the deepening, enlarging, widening and extending of the Morrow Drain, in the Townships of Metcalfe and Brooke, and for borrowing on the credit of the Municipality the sum of \$3303, to be paid to the Council of the Township of Metcalfe for completing the said drainage works.

Provisionally adopted the 15th day of October, A. D. 1887.

WHEREAS, By-Law No. 261, of the Council of the Township of Metcalfe (hereinafter referred to), sets forth that a majority of the owners, as shown by the last revised Assessment Roll, of the property thereafter set forth to be relieved and benefitted by the deepening, enlarging, widening and extending of the Morrow Drain, have petitioned the Council of the Township of Metcalfe, praying that the said drain may be deepened, enlarged, widened and extended till an outlet is obtained in the Township of Brooke, in the County of Lambton.

And that whereas, thereupon the said Council procured an examination to be made by Alexander Davidson, P. L. S., being a person competent for such purpose, of the said locality proposed to be relieved of surface waters brought down by the Township of Ekfrid, and drained, and has also procured plans and estimates of the work to be made by the said Alexander Davidson, P. L. S., and an assessment to be made by him of the real property to be benefitted by such deepening, enlarging, widening and extending of the said drain, stating as nearly as he can the proportion of benefit which in his opinion will be derived in consequence of such deepening, enlarging, widening and extending by every read and lot or portion of lot; the said assessment so made, and the report of the said Alexander Davidson, P. L. S., in respect thereof and of the said deepening, enlarging, widening and extending, being as follows:—

To the Municipal Council of the Township of Metcalfe:

Gentlemen,—I beg to report that in compliance with your instructions I have made an examination of the locality to be relieved and drained (being the lands hereinafter named) by a drain to be constructed, or deepened, enlarged, widened and extended in the Townships of Metcalfe and Brooke, and to be known as the Morrow Drain. I find that a very large quantity of drainage water is brought down upon the lands in the Township of Metcalfe by a drain in the Township of Ekfrid called the Morrow Drain, and by other drains therein from lands and roads in the said Township of Ekfrid, and that such waters so brought down overflow and injure lands in the Township of Metcalfe to such an extent as to make it necessary to provide an outlet therefor. In order to find an outlet for such waters and drainage waters on lands in said Township of Metcalfe, through which the proposed drain is to pass, it is necessary to extend the said drain into lands in the Township of Brooke, whose lands and roads will be benefitted to some extent by the extension of said drain. To obtain an outlet for such drainage waters from Ekfrid, and to drain certain lands in Metcalfe, a drain should be constructed, or deepened, widened and extended, to be known as the Morrow Drain, in the Townships of Metcalfe and Brooke, commencing in the said drain in the Township of Metcalfe, on the north-westerly side of the township between the Townships of Metcalfe and Ekfrid, at the distance of 11 chains and 90 links south-westerly from the south-east angle of lot number 10, in the 14th concession of the said Township of Metcalfe, where a stake marked 0 has been planted, and then running westerly through the Township of Metcalfe and to an outlet 1 chain and 75 links north of the south-west angle of lot No. 26, in the 7th concession of the Township of Brooke, where a stake has been planted marked 281x85, and more definitely shown on the plans marked "A" and "B" accompanying and forming part of this report, following the old drain and the line of stakes showing the location of said drain to be constructed, or deepened, widened and extended. I find, also, that some years ago a drain, forming part of this drain now to be deepened, widened and extended, was constructed from the north half of lot No. 11, in the 14th concession of Metcalfe, to lot No. 15, in the 12th concession of Metcalfe, at a cost of \$1025.58, which drain is now used as an outlet for waters brought down from lands in the Township of Ekfrid as aforesaid. I have therefore assessed said lands in Ekfrid five cents per acre for a due proportion of the cost of construction of said ditch or drain for outlet, according to Section 590 of the Municipal Act of Ontario, 1883, and added it to the assessment of said lands in Ekfrid for the construction, or deepening, widening and extending of said Morrow Drain in the Townships of Metcalfe and Brooke hereinafter referred to. I have assessed the said lands in the Township of Ekfrid so benefitted or drained, or to be benefitted or drained, by using said proposed ditch or drain as an outlet for a due proportion of the cost of constructing, or deepening, widening and extending the said Morrow Drain in the Townships of Metcalfe and Brooke. I have also assessed said lands and roads in Brooke for benefit as per assessment hereto annexed and forming part of this report. I have made plans and profiles and estimates of the work to be done, and which are to form part of this report. I have estimated the cost of the proposed work at \$8918.00, as follows:
