BIG JUMP IN PRICE OF WHEAT

NEW YORK STOCK MARKET MAIN TALK IN STRENGTH.

Toronto and Montreal Stock Exchange—The Market—Local Grain Market—Quiet and Steady—Produce and Poultry—Grain and Current Crop—Miscellaneous.

Monday Evening, Aug. 3. An aggregate of 105 shares of Dominion Bank sold today at 233.

Western Assurance was active and firm, 100 shares selling at 143 1/2 to 144.

Today being a bank holiday in England the produce and stock exchanges there are closed.

Russia has appointed Minister of Justice to punish severely anyone or newspaper publishing crop reports.

Cable from Paris says market very firm. Corn crop is reported to be badly damaged. Crop reports are becoming daily worse.

Transactions on local Stock Exchange aggregated 1,250 shares to-day compared with 100 Friday on Montreal Exchange 12 against 10.

The feature of the local market to-day was the sale of one block of 1000 shares of Northwest Land at 79 1/2.

Stocks of wheat in store in Port Arthur 105,800 bushels, compared with 104,300 last week; stored during week 14,700 bushels, shipped 35,400 bushels.

The visible supply shows an increase in all cereals except barley, which is 270 bushels less. Wheat gained 3,000 bushels, corn 8,781, oats 30,000 and rye 28,200.

A year ago to-day oats sold on the street market at 31c to 31 1/2c, new hay at 80c to 82c, and straw at 87c to 87 1/2c. Straight roller flour offered on call at \$4.80 Toronto freight.

Advised received here that space was secured in New York last week for shipments of about 1,800,000 bushels of grain, and that on Friday and Saturday for export aggregated 1,500,000 bushels.

In spite of over two and a half million bushels increase in the visible supply, the local market to-day was not much changed in values.
