Their Work Quickly—The

Insurance.

The owners of the Langmuir factory in

King's street west, which was burned early

yesterday morning, are certain that it

was a case of incendiarism. Not only

was there no inflammable material in the

portion of the building on which the fire

started, but the street lamp in Niagara-

street near the spot where the flames

were discovered had been lighted by the

policeman on the last 15 minutes before

the alarm. On going around the build-

ing to find out where the smoke was

from P. C. Bogart discovered that the

light was out once more, and that the

incendiarist had done their work within

the preceding quarter of an hour. The
