AQUILEGIA JONESII, Parry.

High slopes of Sheep Mountain, Waterton Lake, Rocky Mountains, Lat. 49° 05', July 29th, 1895. (John Macoun, Herb. No. 10,029.) New to Canada.

BERBERIS NERVOSA, PURSh.

Not rare in deep, moist woods in Trinity Valley, between Mabel Lake and Enderby, B.C., 1895. (*Jas. McEvoy.* Herb. No. 10,133.) Not before recorded east of Yale, B.C.

BERBERIS AQUIFOLIUM, Pursh.

In open thickets, Waterton Lake, Lat. 49° 05', Rocky Mountains, 1895. (John Macoun. Herb. No. 10,267.) Eastern limit in Canada.

## PAPAVER PYRENAICUM, L.

A single specimen collected by Dr. G. M. Dawson in the South Kootanie Pass, Rocky Mountains, 1883. Re-dis-
