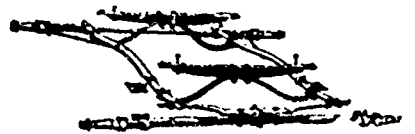

make it like thin jelly. Fill the baked
crust, and bake about fifteen minutes, then
frost them if desired.

cornmeal, two even teaspoonfuls salt, two

buttered pans and bake half an hour. Good

tablespoonfuls of butter, two beaten eggs
