If we believe the Presbyterian system to embody and exhibit more largely than is done elsewhere at once the scriptural polity of church government, and the grand vital doctrines of the gospel, or, "the truth as it is in Jesus," then is it not our duty, earnestly to seek to unite our forces, so far as this can be done consistently with principle, so as to extend and establish the influence of Presbyterian Christianity on the right hand and on the left?
