With the People's Republic of China there is an exchange of 18 students. On behalf of the Department, the AUCC administers the program for Canadian students going to China. On behalf of the Department, the SSHRC administers the program for the Chinese students coming to Canada. In addition, the SSHRC arranges an annual lecture tour for three Chinese professors on behalf of the Department.

Canadian Studies Abroad

Through its program of Canadian Studies Abroad the Department encourages the development of teaching, research and publications about Canada in certain countries (principally in the United States, France, Britain, Germany, Japan, Italy and Belgium). In response to Canadian oriented academic activity initiated by foreign universities and professors, the Department provides: supplementary training to foreign professors agreeing to prepare and teach new or substantially improved courses on Canada which have been approved by their parent universities; limited support for conferences and seminars about Canada organized by foreign universities or related institutions; limited support for Canadian professors invited by foreign universities to teach about Canada as part of their Canadian Studies activities; limited support for Canadian Studies Associations in other countries; assistance to foreign university libraries to obtain books, learned journals and other pedagogical materials on Canada for teaching and research; and limited support to foreign universities developing curricula on Canada for use in the school systems of their countries.
