SYDNEY, AUSTRALIA (CP) - EXTERNAL AFFAIRS MINISTER JOE CLARK SPENT HIS SECOND FULL DAY IN SYDNEY TODAY PREPARING FOR MONDAY'S OPENING IN CANBERRA OF THE FOURTH SESSION OF THE COMMONNEALTH COMMITTEE OF FOREIGN MINISTERS ON SOUTHERN AFRICA.

A SENIOR EXTERNAL AFFAIRS SPOKESHAN SAID CLARK, WHO ARRIVED THURSDAY AFTER A 29-HOUR FLIGHT FROM PARIS WHERE HE ATTENDED THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON CAMBODIA, WAS ALSO MAKING PLANS FOR A SERIES OF BILATERAL DISCUSSIONS WITH SEVERAL OF THE COUNTRIES TAKING PART IN THE THREE-DAY CAMBERRA CONFERENCE.

CLARK IS CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMONHEALTH COMMITTEE CONFERENCE THAT LAST MET IN HARARE, ZIMBABHE, IN FEBRUARY. OTHERS TAKING PART IN THE CONFERENCE ARE THE FOREIGN MINISTERS OF AUSTRALIA, GUYANA, INDIA, NIGERIA, TANZANIA, ZAMBIA AND ZIMBABHE.

CARLK HILL HEET ON SUNDAY HITH COMMONHEALTH SECRETARY GENERAL SIR SONNY RAMPHAL. CLARK HILL ALSO HEET WITH AUSTRALIAN PRIME MINISTER BOB HANKE DURING HIS STAY IN CAMBERRA.

HIS BILATERAL TALKS WITH AUSTRALIA'S FOREIGH KINISTER SENATOR GARETH EVANS WILL BE HELD THURSDAY PRIOR TO LEAVING THE COUNTRY.

THE SPOKESHAN SAID CLARK HILL DISCUSS HITH EVANS AHONG OTHER TOPICS CONSULAR REPRESENTATION IN COUNTRIES OR CITIES WHERE EITHER OF THEH DOES NOT HAVE A CONSULATE.
