INTRODUCTION

1. THE INDUSTRY EXPECTS CAPITAL WORKS IN THE PUBLIC SECTOR ONLY. FROM NOW UNTIL THE YEAR 2000 IN EXCESS OF 15. BILLION U.S.D., A MAJOR PORTION OF THIS EXPENDITURE MUST BE PROVIDED FROM OUTSIDE SOURCES.

2. MAJOR AREAS FOR THESE CAPITAL WORKS ARE:
 - a) PETROLEOS MEXICANOS (PEMEX).
 - b) SECRETARIA DE COMUNICACIONES Y TRASPORTES (SCT).
 - c) COMISION FEDERAL DE ELECTRICIDAD (CFE).
 - d) COMISION NACIONAL DE AGUA (CNA).
 - e) SECRETARIA DE DESARROLLO URBANO Y ECOLOGIA (SEDESOL).
 - f) SEVERAL STATE & MUNICIPAL WATER/WASTE WATER PROJECTS.
 - g) PRIVATIZATION OF D.D.F. WATER DISTRIBUTION/COLLECTION SYSTEM.
 - h) MAJOR LOW COST HOUSING DEVELOPMENTS.

3. THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY IN MEXICO HAS THE PHYSICAL PLANT AND CORPORATE STRUCTURE TO ADEQUATELY EXECUTE THIS MASSIVE CAPITAL PROGRAM.

4. THE INDUSTRY REQUIRES ASSOCIATIONS/JOINT VENTURE PARTNERS WHO HAVE THE MIDDLE & UPPER MANAGEMENT TO ORGANIZE & FINANCE THESE PROJECTS WHICH ARE, FOR THE INDUSTRY, ON A TURNKEY BASIS AND IN THE CASE OF HIGHWAYS & PORTS, ON A TAKE OVER OWNERSHIP BASIS.
