

Proceedings on Adjournment Motion

The Acting Speaker (Mr. Rinfret): Order. I am sorry, but the hon. member cannot raise a question of privilege at this time.

Mr. Jean Chrétien (Saint-Maurice-Lafleche): Mr. Speaker, I rise on a point of order. I should like to point out that during the speech made by the hon. member for Lotbinière (Mr. Choquette), there was not a single Progressive Conservative in the house.

The Acting Speaker (Mr. Rinfret): Order. According to the rules, on the adjournment of

the house, a member can debate a question for which he is granted seven minutes then, the minister concerned or the government spokesman is entitled to three minutes to reply. Therefore, a question of privilege cannot be raised, nor any point of order, at this stage.
