

## THE SENATE OF CANADA

### BILL M<sup>14</sup>.

An Act for the relief of  
Roberta Barbara Shvemar Feigelman.

Preamble.

**W**HEREAS Roberta Barbara Shvemar Feigelman, residing at the town of Dorval, in the province of Quebec, wife of Joel Jerome Feigelman, who is domiciled in Canada and residing at the city of Montreal, in the said province, has by her petition alleged that they were married on the thirtieth day of June, A.D. 1946, at the said city, she then being Roberta Barbara Shvemar, a spinster; and whereas by her petition she has prayed that, because of his adultery since then, their marriage be dissolved; and whereas the said marriage and adultery have been proved by evidence adduced and it is expedient that the prayer of her petition be granted: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

Marriage dissolved.

**1.** The said marriage between Roberta Barbara Shvemar and Joel Jerome Feigelman, her husband, is hereby dissolved, and shall be henceforth null and void to all intents and purposes whatsoever.

Right to marry again.

**2.** The said Roberta Barbara Shvemar may at any time hereafter marry any man whom she might lawfully marry if the said marriage with the said Joel Jerome Feigelman had not been solemnized.
