In one place, Scripture itself gives us a charter to do as we please, but with one important condition attached : " Rejoice O young man in thy youth ; and let thy heart cheer thee in the days of thy youth ; and walk in the ways of thy heart. and in the sight of thine eyes : but know thou that for all these things God shall bring thee into judgment."
