The Pinguin here mentioned, is different from that which is described by our ingenious countryman Mr. Pennant, under the name of the Patagonian Pinguin; and answers more exactly to the second species or lesser Proguin speken of by that gentleman, and which is otherwise called, Anser Magellanicus Clusii, &c. It is probable that Don Pernety never saw the Patagonian Pinguin, since he says nothing of it. The Reader will find an accurate account of the different species of this singular bird, in the 58th volume of the Philosophical Transactions, which contains Mr. Pennant's paper on that subject.
