Expedience of XXX. THERE are in every flate fome perfons who are diffinguished from the rest by a superiority of birth, or riches, or honours. These persons it will be fit and prudent to entrust with a greater fhare of the publick authority of the flate than is allowed to the reft of the people, who are fo much their inferiours.
