MUST inform you of the work of God, which is going on in their parts. Early in May, an attention to religion began in the first fociety in Mansfield, which increased to a great degree. In as to become general. It then began in Humpton, where it is as general as in Mansfield. About four weeks fince, it began here, and, for the time, has firrend very fast; fo that about eighty have been under great concern: Of this number, nearly twenty have a good hope they have been " born again." The work feems to be foreading. In one fimily of my people who have only three little daughters, the eldeft fifteen years old, they all give evidence that they have been born again 1. The work has also began in Mr. WelfN's fociety in Mansfield; and the prospects are very favorable in Welford.— Do unite in prayer that God would pour out his Spirit upon yon. If only two or three can be induced to engage don't omit it. This feems to have been the beginning of the work in Mansfield.
