Head Quarters, November 3d, 1814.

SIR,

YOUR note dated (I presume by mistake) the 2d November, is received this day. Large boats for your purpose will be provided, and *nothing* of value must be left. You can, should you be molested, defend yourself, and will of course, be duly supported. It is from choice, not force, that we relinquish an useless conquest; and if the latter be resorted to, we will keep it.
