ZACATULA, a small port-town of the province of Mechoacan, situated at the mouth of a river of the same name, on the coast of the Pacific ocean. Lat. 17. 22. N. long. 104. 58. W.

AMORA, a city of Peru, in S. America, 200 miles south of Quito. It is pretty large, and the houses well-built of timber and stone. The church and convent of Dominicans are both elegant structures. There are several gold mines in the neighbourhood of the city, but few of them worked. Lat. 4. 10. S. long. 77. 5. W.
