

RULES OF ORDER
OF THE
College : Street : Baptist : Church

Section No. 1—Members.

ART. 1. Any person professing faith in the Lord Jesus Christ, giving evidence of a change of heart, and adopting the views of faith and practice held by this church, as set forth in the foregoing Declaration, and accepting the foregoing Covenant, may, upon baptism, be received into its membership.

ART. 2. At each annual meeting a committee shall be appointed, consisting of the Deacons, Clerk and five other members (seven to form a quorum), who shall meet at least once a month. Their duty shall be to interview and examine all applicants for membership, whether by baptism or experience, and for this purpose the Secretary of the Committee shall give due and timely notice to all applicants of the place and time of meeting. In special cases, where necessity requires, they may appoint from among themselves a sub-committee to wait on applicants, said sub-committee to report on same to the Membership Committee, who will report to the Church. The Pastor shall preside at all meetings, but in case of his absence the Committee shall elect a chairman *pro. tem.* All
