

The handle is unfolded, its hinge joint locked, and then inserted into the jack lever socket (notched edge downward) and pushed in as far as it will go, which sets jack for raising.

Handle being thus held into the socket by a spring catch, jack may now be pushed under car and placed for lifting from the outer end of the long handle, while the operator remains in an easy position back of the car. The ordinary pumping motion raises the load in the usual way.

To reverse the jack movement the handle is twitched backward, after which a continued pumping motion lowers the load; and as it is still fast in the socket, jack may be pulled out from under the car by handle. Handle is then removed from the jack by releasing the spring catch under socket, and folded for storing.






