LAW TO CONTROL FEMALE REFUGES

Will Limit Magistrates' Powers Concerning Indefinite Sentences.

Legislation that will affect in many ways industrial refuges for females in Ontario is now before the legislature. Heretofore it was permitted to sentence females to these institutions for an indefinite period not exceeding five years.

The main object of the new act is to take care of those obvious discrepancies. Hereafter magistrates will only be permitted to sentence females to these institutions for an indefinite period not exceeding two years.
