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A MUNICIPAL CONVENTION

Ald. Sheppard Propounds a Bright

Idea That May Result in General

Municipal Improvement.

Ald. Sheppard is to the fore with an

excellent idea. Recognizing the fact that

the Municipal Act is constantly being

modified without affording general

satisfaction, he proposes that a provin-

cial convention of mayors, wardens and

recesses be held in this city some time

next January, before or during the ses-

sion of the Legislature, and that various

maters of common interest be talked

over, such as the Municipal Act, school

systems, police systems, fire systems,

bona systems, license systems, roads

and bridges, and other matters of

general interest. The Provincial

Association shall be formed, to meet

annually, biennially or triennially, with

representatives from all the cities, towns

and villages, the same as in the

Association of Trade, that papers shall

be read at these gatherings, to be sub-

sequently discussed, and the results of

the discussion shall be reported to the

Legislature. The worthy alderman will

probably bring the matter up in Coun-

cil at an early date.

WILL FIGHT EXTRADITION

Dr. Nancy Guilford Will Take the

Stand in Bow Street Court on

Her Own Behalf.

London, Oct. 15.-Dr. Nancy Guilford

will go on the witness stand in the Bow

street Court at the extradition hearing,

when the American officer arrives, and

privilege could not have been secured

for her, and the Criminal Evidence Act

came into effect today, giving any

prisoner the right to testify in his own

behalf without any restrictions or

prejudices. And even if the prisoner

sees acquittal by false swearing, he

cannot be indicted for perjury on

that account.

place her on the stand, hoping thus to

bring out the full story of her life, and

show that she is a woman of high

character, and that her flight from

America was a necessary one.
