DIVISION OF THE PROVINCE. By alterations, recently made by the Legislature, in reference to the division of the Province, the County of Sydney has been divided into the Counties of Sydney and Guysborough; the County of Shelburne into the counties of Shelburne and Yarmouth; the County of Cape Breton, into the counties of Cape Breton, Richmond, and Inverness.

The County of Sydney comprises the Upper District of the former County; the County of Guysborough includes the Lower District; the County of Shelburne comprises that part of the former County, called the District of Shelburne.

The County of Yarmouth comprises "the Township of Yarmouth and Argyle, and also that part which lies north west of a line running north-east from the N. E. corner of a grant on the east side of the great Pulnico Lake, made to David Larkins and others, to the bounds of the County of Annapolis;" which was formerly the District of Yarmouth and Argyle.

The County of Cape Breton comprises that part of the Island, known by the name of the North-Eastern District. The County of Richmond includes that division formerly called the Southern District. The County of Inverness comprises what was formerly the North-Western District.
