THE Managers in presenting the twenty-third Annual Report of the Congregation, are thankful to be able to state, that the Contributions of the Congregation during the past year have been fully maintained, and that after paying all its indebtedness to the 31st inst., there remains in the hands of the Treasurer a balance of \$766.40.

The Receipts from all sources have amounted to \$4087.09, made up as follows.

The Expenditure for the year has amounted to \$4,061.24. For the previous year the Receipts were \$4,082.72, and the Expenditure was \$4,262.15, showing an increase in the Receipts for the year just passed of \$4.37, and a decrease in the Expenditure of \$100.91.

It is also gratifying to know that the Missionary Contributions for the past years have exceeded those of any previous years. At the last Annual meeting reference was made to the necessity for repairs to the pews in, and the fence, around the Church. In the early part of the year, these matters were under the consideration of the managers, and enquiry was made as to the cost of painting and renovating the interior of the Church.
