TO LET—STORE IN THE LINE OF friends and the joint distribution committee are to be seen every hour driving along Marsalkowska and Alcia Jerolimowska taking supplies to the widows at which thousands of people are fed. A large number of refugees crowd Warsaw; many of them are entirely without resources and become the peculiar objects of the relief societies.

The student population is also in a peculiar state of need. Most of the students in Warsaw and try to carry on their studying at the same time. No one in Poland can really afford the luxury of sufficient time for an education in the real sense of the word. Technical learning must be sacrificed to the pressing needs of life itself in a situation which six years of incessant war has left barren of academic opportunities. The portion of the population which seems particularly in need at the present time, however, is the upper middle class, the "intelligentsia" and the small capitalist of former days.

Now there any chance of the situation's improvement soon. Exchange rates have dropped steadily until the pound sterling stands at 207 1/2 in Warsaw as this is written. Without the relief societies this winter a large section of Poland would starve. In addition to almost famine conditions and object poverty involving whole classes of the population, there are both typhus and cholera in various localities. The relief societies have a stupendous task before them, even if peace is made and maintained between Poland and Russia, Poland is trying to get gold from Russia for the peace negotiations to help bolster up exchange rates; but food, nurses, medicine and expert management are immediately necessary in large quantities to save Poland. An immense relief work is being done; but the needs are so great as to escape all calculation. Two much relief is impossible. A very brief survey of Polish conditions leads one at once to the conclusion that peace, permanent and friendly, is essential to the future of the new republic—Paul W. Ward.
