Paris, June 12—Amid frantic applause by the members of the left and the extreme left in the chamber of deputies today the ministry of Alexandre Felix Ribot, which was formed only yesterday to succeed that of Gaston Doumergue, was defeated in a vote on its declaration of policy and then given a vote of lack of confidence. Premier Ribot and his ministers immediately picked up their portfolios and left the chamber to present their resignations to President Poincare.


