## THE TRUE LOYALISTS

The appeal of the Conservatives in this campaign is to ignorance and prejudice. If the people of Canada were ignorant instead of intelligent; and if they were easily influenced by prejudice, instead of being fair-minded and endowed with hard common sense, they might listen to the inflammatory appeals made to them by the Conservative press and speakers.

But the people are far too well informed to be hoodwinked in this matter of reciprocity. They will treat with the contempt it deserves the insinuation that their loyalty is measured by the extent to which they keep up the tariff walls; or the suggestion that greater prosperity would make them less devoted to the flag of their country.

They know that the trade agreement is not a treaty, such as the Conservatives were so eager for years to secure, but an agreement that can be terminated at any time.

By what right do the Conservatives claim to be the only loyal citizens of Canada? Is it because they have allied themselves with Mr. Henri Bourassa? Is it because they opposed a preference for England unless England gave a preference in return?

The facts are all against these gentlemen. The true loyalists are those who seek to strengthen the Empire by bringing prosperity and building up the Dominion of Canada.

## THE TORY CANDIDATES

Now that Dr. Daniel has been re-nominated, the electors of St. John city and county will ask themselves what he has done as their representative to assist the minister of public works in advancing the interests of this constituency, and especially of St. John as a national port. The more closely the record is scrutinized, especially in connection with his ridicule in 1909 of the proposed Courtney Bay improvements, the more they will be convinced that they should vote for Mr. James Lowell.

With regard to the Conservative victim in the city, perhaps it may as well be Mr. H. A. Powell as another, although it is to be regretted that at so early a stage in the campaign he should stoop to mere vituperation as a method of dealing with his opponents. That sort of talk may tickle the ears of the groundlings, but thoughtful people are not favorably impressed.

There were the usual loud boasts last night of a great Conservative victory. There was even a telegram telling that Hon. Mr. Bower, just back from England, predicts a clean sweep in British Columbia. This is one way of proving that reciprocity is not desirable, but not perhaps the most effective.

Of course there was flag-waving. That is the piece-de-resistance at every Tory feast. But if the mother country should ask Canada to conclude a trade arrangement with some country solely for the benefit of the mother country, what would these light-souled patriots say about it? They even opposed the British preference because Canada did not get a preference in return.

The electors of St. John are not afraid of themselves, or of their ability to remain loyal to the British flag, even if the gamblers between this port and Boston should take out full cargoes. To say, as was said last night at the Conservative convention that a trade agreement which can be terminated at will endangers the integrity of the British Empire is a gross insult to the people of Canada.

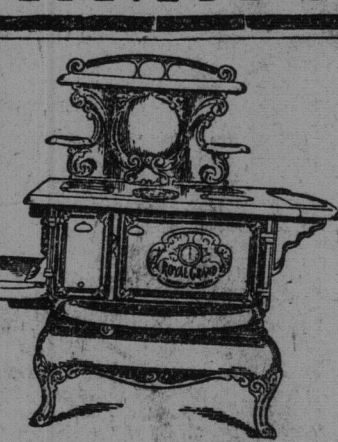
