

FIFTH WITNESS

D26852 Gnr DEPATIE JA, 22 CSEC, having been duly sworn states:

I've been billeted in No 9 Hut 22 CSEC since we moved there in Jan. with the exception of 2 wks when I worked on the kitchen staff. The accused whom I now recognize, lives in hut 9 and I was living there when he moved in. When he moved in he brought a bk box on his shoulder with him, and Exhibit "A" is the bk box. This box was always there when I was there. I've seen him open the box, although I didn't see him put anything in it or take anything out of it.

Q. What did he open it for?  
A. I don't know, sir.

CROSS EXAMINED

Q. Did you actually see the accused take the lid and lift it up?  
A. Yes.

Q. Before giving evidence you had words with Tpt Beaudoin?  
A. No.

Q. Aren't you scared that the accused knows something is going on between you and Tpr Beaudoin?  
A. No.

Q. You're sure of that?  
A. Yes.

SIXTH WITNESS

I'm billeted in Hut 9 22 CSEC and have been there for and over 3 mths. I recognize the accused who was billeted in Hut 9 also. He came in after I did, and he brought his kit in and a wooden box, and Exhibit "A" is the box. He carried it and placed it under his bed where it remained until it was removed by an offr. I've seen him on several occasions open the box with a key.

CROSS EXAMINED

Q. Do you know Depatie?  
A. Yes.

Q. He's a good pal of yours?  
A. I've known him several months sir.

Q. Were you not scared that the accused would say something against you?  
A. No, I'm not scared.

Q. Did you and Depatie fix things up to put the accused in the hole?  
A. No.

Q. Are you sure that Exhibit "A" is the box that the accused brought into the room?  
A. Yes, I can tell by the name on the box.

Q. How did he bring it into the room?  
A. He had it in his hand.
