PLANS NOT TO RETURN TO MEXICO

General Diaz in Paris, is still Deeply Interested in the Welfare of his Country.

MADE NO ATTACK ON PRESIDENT MADERO.

Hopeful of Nephew's Success, But Takes No Sides in French Press.

Paris, Oct. 21.—General Porfirio Diaz, ex-President of Mexico, declared today that his intention of not returning to Mexico was unchanged. He is staying at a hotel here and has shown great interest in the news concerning his nephew Felix Diaz, and the taking of the port of Vera Cruz. He said, however, that he was totally without private advice from Mexico and continued:

"Under the circumstances I prefer not to express any opinion relative to my nephew's intentions and chances."

Naturally, he said, he was not connected in any way with the present movement. His only object, as he had on many occasions intimated, was to see a peaceful Mexico, which this would be given a chance to develop, grow and thrive. General Diaz is greatly disturbed in regard to several interviews purporting to be from him which have been published in Paris, and in which he has been quoted as attacking President Madero. He said these statements were untrue, and added that he had been so misquoted that he would prefer to say nothing more.
