

twenty-one and the west boundary of section sixteen to the south-west corner of the south-west quarter of said section sixteen; thence easterly following the south boundaries of sections sixteen and fifteen to the place of commencement, containing by admeasurement nineteen hundred and twenty acres more or less, all as shown outlined in pink on a copy of the plan of Fisher River Indian Reserve number 44, of record in the Department of the Interior, under number 17,228 a copy of which is hereto attached.
