AT a COURT of GENERAL QUARTER SESSIONS of the PEACE, begun and holden for the DISTRICT of MONTREAL, on THURSDAY, the TENTH day of JULY, 1817, and continued by adjournment to SATURDAY, the NINETEENTH day of the same month.

THE COURT suspend the execution of the Thirty-fifth Article of the REGULATIONS OF POLICE, passed in the last APRIL SESSIONS, until the first day of MAY next.

It is further ordered, in addition to the Second Article of the said REGULATIONS, respecting the HAY MARKET, that all and every persons bringing hay for sale on the said market, shall be held on their arrival thereon, to have the said hay weighed by the Clerk of the said Market, or his Deputy, and to give his name to the said Clerk or his Deputy, and also the name of the owner of the said Hay, if he be not the owner himself, under the penalty of leaving the said
