That a prisoner be liberated and given a letter to the commanding officer at Carlton, inviting him in the name of God and of humanity to come and take away the bodies of the unfortunate who fell yesterday on his side, in the combat ; that far from being molested he will be accompanied by our condolences in the fulfilment of that sorrowful duty ; that we will wait till to-morrow noon. Moved by Mr. Monkman, seconded by Mr. John Baptiste Boucher, and unanimously carried. Dated March 27th, 1885.
