INTRODUCTION.

VOLUMB SECOND.

This volume being the second of the series, but the third of the issue, comprises fifteen tables, and are numbered from VII. to XX. and an addendum A.

Table VII. being the first of this volume, gives the number of births during the twelve months immediately preceding the 4th April, 1881. The months in which such births occurred, and the sexes, when known, and when not known, adding them to the totals.

It must be remembered that in the births, deaths and other informations relating to the Provinces of Manitoba and British Columbia and the Territories, reliable informationis not obtainable, covering, as they do, a large Indian population. In British Columbia they were estimated and given in bulk.

Table VIII. Ages of the people are given as recorded year by year, and are counted from the last birth-day. The column headed under one year, therefore represents a greater or lesser fraction of a year, and those headed 1 to 2, 2 to 3, &c., successively, represent the numbers of persons living at one year of age last birth-day and two years of age last birth-day, &c.

Tables IX. to XIII. require no explanations.
