An Act to authorise the several Township Councils in Upper Canada to re-divide their respective Townships into School Sections.

THEREAS since the several Townships of Upper Canada were Preamble. divided into School sections, a great increase has taken place in population, and a re-division of School sections has in consequence become necessary; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. A special meeting of the Municipal Council of every Township, specially called for the purpose, by the Reeve, or in his absence by the Deputy Reeve, after due notice shall have been given, by publishing the ship Council same, either in the newspapers of the County, or by posting notices in twelve of the most conspicuous places in the Township, shall be held, to 10 take into consideration the necessity and propriety of altering the School ing them if ne-Divisions as at present existing in any such Township, at which meeting cessary. all the Trustees of the various School Sections in the said Township and the local Superintendent of the same, shall be notified to attend; and at such meeting or any adjournment thereof, it shall and may be lawful 15 for the said Council, to alter or change, add to or take from, or otherwise alter any School Section within the limits of their Township, or to abolishthe whole and re-divide the Township anew, as the case may require: Proviso. Provided always, that where School-houses have been built, such Schoolhouses shall at all times, in any such re-arrangement, reconstruction or 20 re-division, be taken as the centre of the particular School Section in which they are situate.

III. All alterations and additions so agreed upon shall be embodied in a Alterations to By-law to be passed by the Municipality, and shall take effect, unless it in a By-law. be provided to the contrary in such By-law, on the first day of January next following the passing of such By-law.

IV. Thereupon the limits of the School Sections so fixed and defined School secshall continue to be the limits to be observed in the said Township for a to remain for period of ten years thereafter at least, and shall not during that period be at least ten subject to be in anywise altered, changed or repealed by any By-law or years. act of the Township Council, or other authority having power to make 35 alterations or changes in such Divisions.

V. All Acts or parts of Acts contrary to the provisions hereof are Inconsistent hereby repealed.
