

**WASHINGTON TREATY:**—Motion for an Address for copies of all correspondence respecting monetary consideration to be paid by the United States to Canada, under the Treaty of Washington, for the liberty of fishing in Canadian waters; Debate adjourned, 89. Motion withdrawn, 153.

2. Motion (Mr. Kirkpatrick) in favor of enlarging the Canal so as to pass vessels drawing 14 feet of water; Ruled out of order, 191. Another motion to a similar effect proposed by Mr. Holton, 313. Passed in the Negative, 314.
