

NOTE.—Of the Map accompanying the foregoing “Statement” only one Copy is sent, but it can be lithographed for the Appendices of the House, if required. It simply represents, in green, the whole watershed of Hudson’s Bay (north of the 49th parallel) as belonging to the Company, under their Charter, and, in pink, the whole Country, thence westward to the Pacific, &c. as “Indian Territories” held under the Lease now about to expire.

NOTE.—The two old Maps sent herewith (which can be lithographed for the Appendices of the House, if required) are but samples of a number of the same kind,—the one representing the English view of the extent of the Hudson’s Bay Territory, and the other the French and general European view thereof, subsequent to the Treaty of Utrecht (1713) and till long after the conquest of Canada.
