General interest courses popular

The most popular night school courses in Peel County are business and commerce subjects with dressmaking taking the all time high enrolment for a single course.

A report to the board of education's advisory vocational committee reveals that a full 50 per cent of this year's record 5,800 night school students are involved in general interest courses.

The board had anticipated the demand for new and different general interest courses and introduced 11 new ones including wigmaking, Chinese cooking, home movie making, new math for parents, charm and personality and flower arranging.

More than 1,000 people enrolled in business and commerce subjects while 710 took up dressmaking. Grade 13 level high school diploma subjects attracted 300 adults and conversational French drew 200.

The Peel County board offered a partial credit system this year in high school diploma courses to prepare the way for the mandatory switch over to a full credit system next year. The provincial department of education has notified the board that his will be the final year for offering program type courses.

The new credit curriculum allows the student greater freedom to choose subjects which will enable him to complete his secondary school graduation diploma.


The board report notes, however, that the high standards set by the department of education will place a severe strain on the financial obligations of the adult evening school program. The problem will have to be met by "a great deal of study and program assessment."

The move towards decentralization is clearly borne out this year by the fact that night school classes are offered in all of the county's 16 secondary schools. The program involved 145 courses and requires the services of 200 teachers.
