It, together with the high cost of living, with which the Government has shewn itself wholly inadequate to cope, accounts more than all else for what there is of unrest and discontent throughout Canada to-day. Relief to consumers and producers in the economic field, and a return to representative and responsible government in the political, are what the country is demanding to-day. Unhappily, His Excellency's speech affords no indication that on the part of His Excellency's advisers there is any disposition to grant these obvious and much needed reforms.
