The High Commissioner states that since Canadian oil import requirements are arranged in Washington the Petroleum Division of the Ministry of Fuel and Power in Britain lacks information on Canada's existing stocks, future requirements, and curtailment programmes. The United Kingdom government suggests that this information would assist in co-ordination and comparison of United Kingdom and Dominion programmes.
