

proposed disallowance of the Thomas school, I think it would be better to endeavor to induce the Six Nation Indian Council to consent to have that school also placed under the School Board, or to have it closed. I fear that were the Dept. to disallow the school or the salary of the teacher, it might be considered by the Council a high-handed proceeding and cause bitter feelings, which it is always advisable if possible to avoid occasioning.
