



Sir,

With reference to Constable Rayner's account rendered at \$24.40, which you forwarded recently, I beg to say that the Department of Justice (when taxing the account, in accordance with the usual custom) pointed out that Mr Rayner has charged \$1.50 for attending the trial, but that he is not entitled to this fee unless the trial took more than four hours. Kindly therefore advise the Department of the length of time covered by the trial.
