Responsibility for calling up single men and childless widowers for military training entrusted to Department of National War Services.

National War Services Regulations, 1940 (Recruits) enacted Aug. 27/40 (P.C. 4185)

13 National War Service Boards established. Each board consists of a judge and two other persons. Their duties consist chiefly in hearing appeals for exemption from or postponement of military training.

In each of the 13 administrative divisions, there is a divisional registrar whose duties are to prepare from duplicate registration cards lists of men to be called up for service.

September 13th, 1940 - Proclamation issued calling out men for military training in the 21, 22, 23 year old classes.
