Ex.: Though he was corrected yet he did not reform.

Bien qu'il fut corrigé il ne se corrigea cependant pas.

20 Whether..... or

Ex.: Whether there be few or many.

Qu'il y en ait peu ou plusieurs.

30 Either or

Ex.: He was either ashamed or afraid.

Il avait honte ou il avait peur.

40 Neither..... nor

Ex.: Neither Peter nor John sleeps.

Ni Pierre ni Jean ne dorment.

50 As..... as

Ex.: He is as wise as his brother (is wise)

Il est aussi sage que son frère.

60 So..... that

Ex.: He is so weak that he cannot work.

Il est si faible qu'il ne peut pas travailler.
