whom she met on her way down at Platon. He was with his daughter and companions resting on the beach. I then learned that the girl was strangely better when met at Platon; that she was eating strawberries her father picked for her; that she had answered the woman who asked her what she was eating, saying: "I am eating strawberries my father has brought me." She would not say any more although many questions were asked. She had spoken some time before, after her departure from Ste Anne but with difficulty and as if choosing her words. For several months before coming here in fulfilment of her vow, she had not spoken, as I have already stated.

"Such are the most accurate details I can give regarding the circumstances accompanying the marvelous fact I have just related."
