

The fiscal year, beginning with the first of July, 1902, and ending with the 30th of June, 1903, is known as the fiscal year 1903. Consequently the crops produced during the calendar year 1902 would not be available for export until the fiscal year 1903, and the crop produced in the calendar year 1903 until the fiscal year 1904.

### Exports of Wheat

According to the Trade and Navigation Reports published by the Dominion Government, the total Canadian wheat exports to all countries for the fiscal year 1903 amounted to 32,985,745 bushels, and \$1,287,766 barrels of flour were exported; for the fiscal year 1904 the exports were 32,885,559 bushels of wheat and 1,587,949 barrels of flour. Assuming that it takes  $4\frac{1}{4}$  bushels of wheat to make a barrel of flour, the Canadian exports of wheat and flour for the fiscal years 1903 and 1904 would together require 68,812,021 bushels of wheat, but the quantity of wheat produced in Ontario, Manitoba and the Northwest Territories was, as already shown, 171,155,307 bushels in two years.

### Exports of Oats

The exports of oats from the whole of Canada amounted to 7,593,177 bushels in the fiscal year 1903, and to 4,695,475 bushels
