Ordered on Motion of Mr. *Palmer*, That the Papers relative to the late Committee of Correspondence be delivered to the Chairman of our present Committee of Correspondence.

Ordered on Motion of Mr. *M'Aulay*, That the Bill, entitled "An Act concerning Land Surveyors and admeasurement of Land," receive a second reading.

Ordered on Motion, That the House resolve itself into a Committee of the whole House to resume the consideration of the Bill, entitled *An Act, to alter and amend an Act, made and passed in the 42d year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled an Act to alter and amend an Act in addition to, and amendment of, an Act, made and passed in the 35th year of his present Majesty's Reign, entitled an Act to alter and amend the High Road Laws*, Mr. *C. Stewart, Jun.* in the Chair.

After some time spent therein the Speaker resumed the Chair and the Chairman reported progress, and desired leave to sit again.

The Committee appointed to wait on His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor with the Address of this House recommending Captain *John McDonald's* Petition returned and reported, That His Excellency was pleased to say he would cheerfully agree with their desire.
