

PASSENGERS OF TRAIN RESCUED FROM BOATS

Passengers in a train on the south of France line between Almarques and Algués-Mortes, in the Gard Department, had a thrilling experience on Thursday night.

Rescuers Have Hard Work in Getting Them Off on Improvised Lifeline.

The train left the station of St. Laurent-d'Algués at 8.40 P. M., and had succeeded about two miles, when the engine driver and stoker noticed that they were traveling in a running stream of water.

After traveling 400 yards the guard's van and the rear coaches were found to be getting into deep water. The train was caught between two streams, which were rapidly rising.

The whistle was heard at the station of St. Laurent, and the station master at once gained a rescue party, but it was found impossible to get within 500 yards of the train.

There was no time to lose, for the water were rising rapidly and the passengers were clambering on to the roofs of the coaches. So strong was the current that the rowing boat was carried away, and half an hour elapsed before the sailors reached the train.

The passengers were then taken out of the flooded train into the boat, and, using the line as a guide rope, the boats were sent to land until all the passengers had been safely taken off. It was 3 o'clock on Friday morning before the rescue was completed.


