The aldermen insist that the whole sum of \$3,000 be paid by the city and not the general estimates. The city solicitor refused to alter his decision.

It was unanimously decided to be announced in deciding that when the fund is exhausted the city will be liable for the sum and the committee shall disavow. There is no doubt that the committee will disavow.
