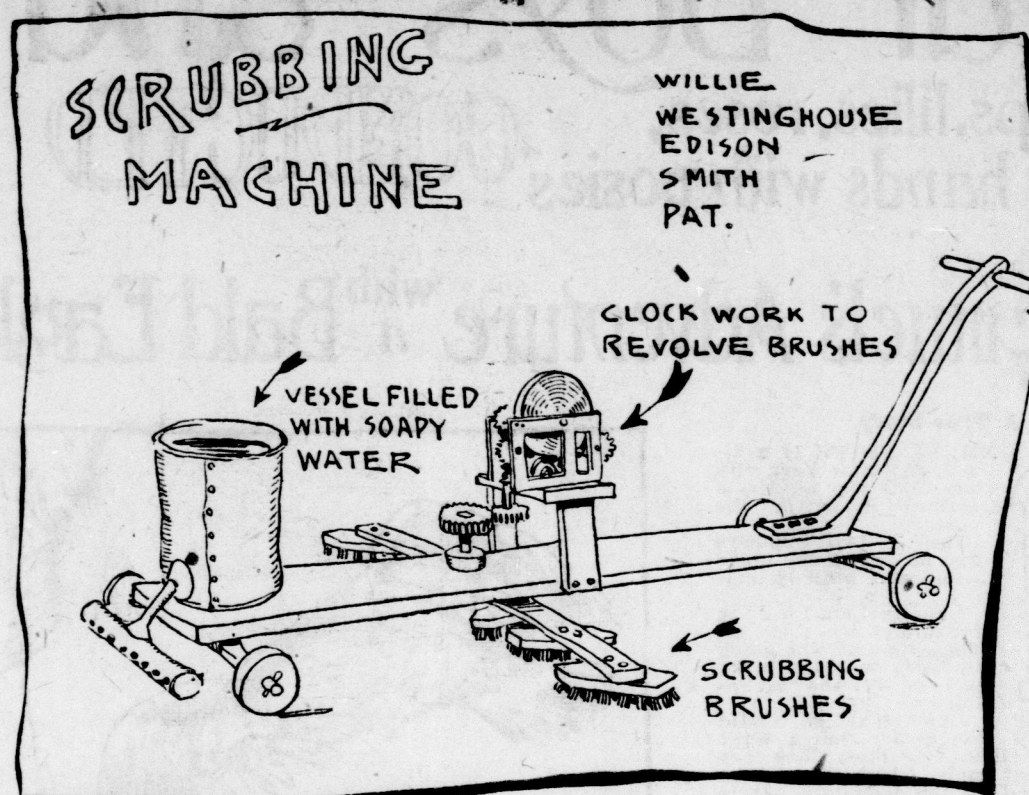


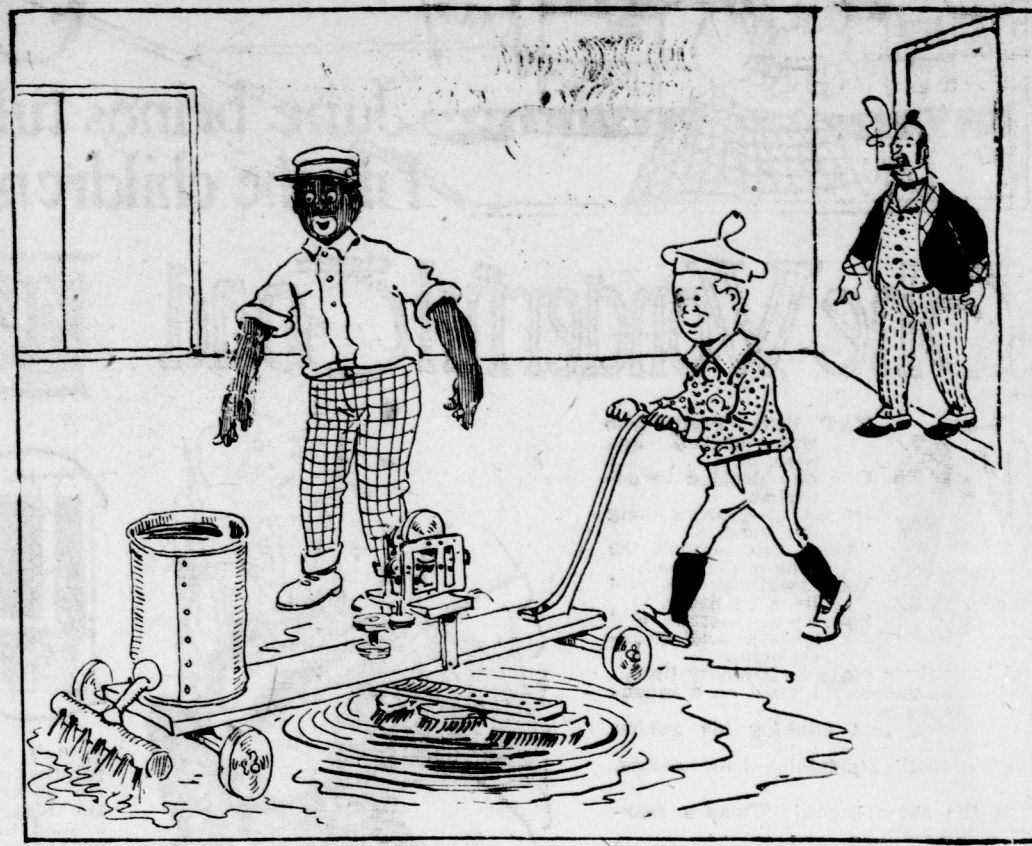
WILLIE WESTINGHOUSE'S BRILLIANT FLOOR-SCRUBBING IDEA



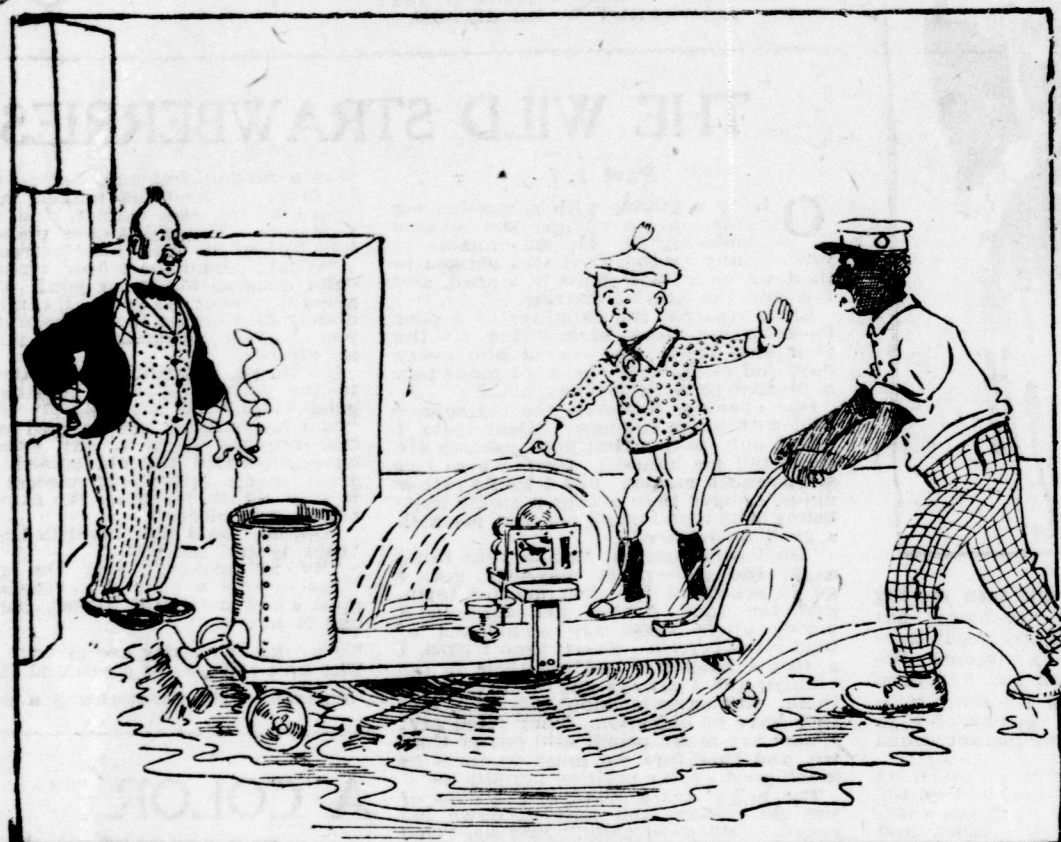
Dear, Tommy—It takes Jim and another man all Saturday afternoon to scrub the office floors.



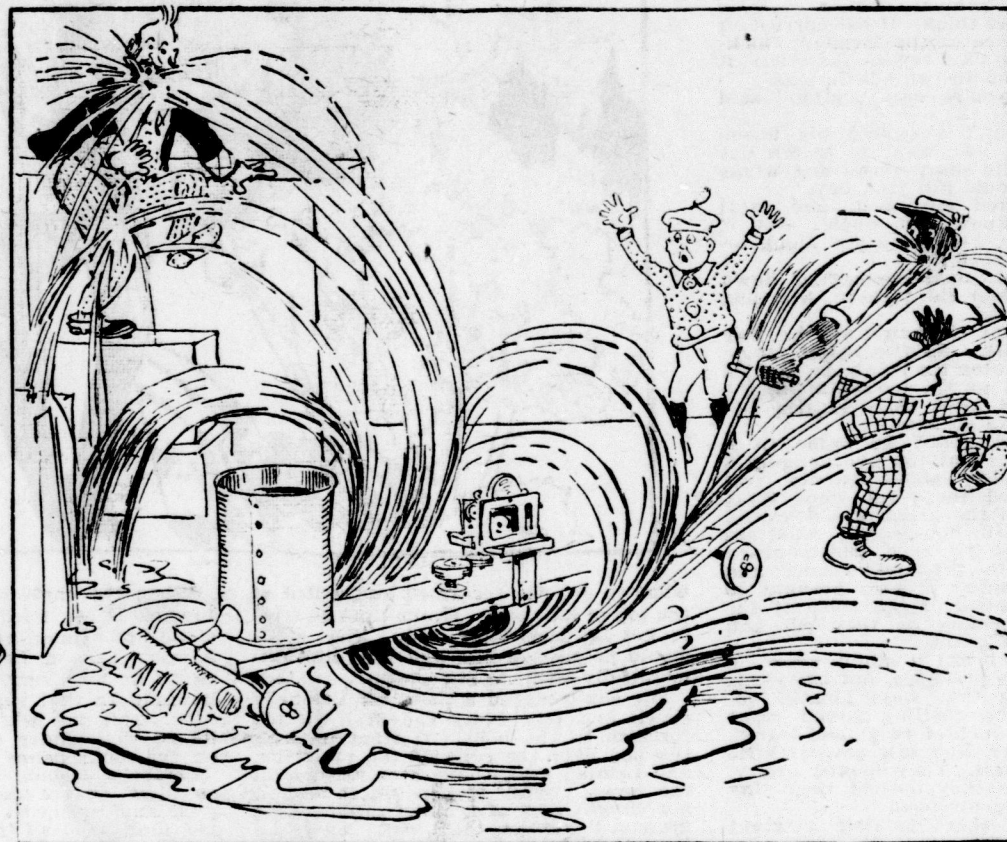
Here is a diagram of a machine I built to relieve them of some of the labor.



I could run it myself and do as much work as four men.



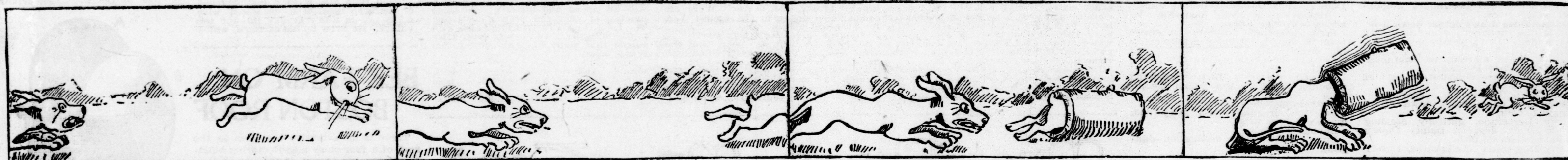
Papa watched it work for a while and said it was a wonder.
