MR. GLADSTONE'S SPEECHES IN PARLIAMENT.

LONDON, April 24.—Mr. Gladstone's speech in the House of Commons this evening in support of Parnell's motion rejecting the government's Irish Land Purchase bill, was a disappointing one to his friends and a political opportunity.

He Says the Measure is an Obstacle to Make the Relations Between Both Countries.

LONDON, April 24.—The land purchase bill was presented in the Commons this evening. Mr. Gladstone spoke in opposition to the government bill, being, as he said, convinced that the measure was not only complicated, but that it did not undertake to solve the difficulty. He had been encouraged to hope for a solution of the question by the declaration of Lord Salisbury that the government plan would not impose a burden upon the taxpayers of Great Britain, but he had been disappointed to find Mr. Balfour informing the House that the measure placed the country to the extent of £23,000,000, without mentioning the possibility of further amounts being added.
